

2019 Coaches Pitch Tournament

Anything not covered by these rules must follow Regular Season Rules found in the *2019 Little League Rule Book*.

These tournament games are considered Special Games by Little League. Regular Season Little League Insurance will be used. Leagues that do not use Little League Insurance must provide a copy of the Insurance forms they provided to Little League.

The host league will provide a PA announcer.

Indiana District 6 is providing Trophies and Baseballs

Eligibility

- Players must be Little League, league age 6, 7, or 8.
- Players must have played in the league's 2019 regular season.
- Teams must provide a roster sheet, birth certificates to validate age, and a Little League Medical Release. This information must be provided prior to the start of games on Friday, June 28, 2019.

Teams

- Roster Size - maximum 14 players, minimum 12 players.
- Four coaches minimum.
 - One coach must always be in the dugout.
 - Only base coaches (1st base and 3rd base) may coach the offensive players.
 - Pitching coach may not function as a base coach.
 - No defensive coaches are permitted on the field.
 - When not on the field, coaches must be the dugout, not standing in foul ball territory.
- Only players on the roster sheet turned in at the start of the tournament will be allowed on a game lineup card.
- Only players and coaches on the game lineup card are permitted to be in the dugout during the game.
- All players on the lineup card bat.
- Ten players on the field play defensively. Four must be in the outfield grass.
- Nine players must be on the lineup card to start the game. If fewer than ten players are on the lineup card, the tenth batting position is an automatic out.
- Players who arrive late to the game may be added to the lineup card.
- A coin toss determines the home team.

Tournament Format

- Each team will play two pool games before tournament play.
- One team has the bye. Other teams will be seeded.
- Tie breaker is runs allowed followed by runs scored followed by coin toss.
- Tournament play is single elimination.
- The game MVPs are chosen and awarded by opposing team coach.

Equipment

- All regular season equipment rules apply.

Field Dimensions

- 35' pitching rubber with normal 10' pitching mound will serve the purpose of the "pitcher's circle."

Umpires

- The host league will provide 2 umpires per game.
- One umpire will be positioned behind the catcher and one behind the pitcher.

Playing Rules

Pitching

- The pitcher must keep one foot inside the pitcher's circle.
- The pitcher must pitch with a foot on or behind the rubber.
- The pitcher must pitch overhand.

Base Running

- Runners may advance one additional base on an overthrow to first base provided the runner is attempting the additional base. An overthrow is when the ball goes behind the first baseman.
- The defense must stop the lead runner to stop play. The umpire then calls time.
- No courtesy runners.
